Lighthouse Academy at Newburg is excited to announce a new partnership program! This fall, children and families might notice new plaques around Lighthouse. These plaques showcase a growing partnership program called Room Naming and Grade Sponsoring. This new program will enable local organizations to partner with Lighthouse Academy at Newburg to help support Lighthouse students. The Room Naming and Grade Sponsoring program will allow new funds to be circulated into the classrooms and common areas to purchase needed items, like school supplies or even aid in appliance repairs. We are proud to share our first partner, Humana Healthy Horizons. Humana Healthy Horizons will sponsor our



Kitchen, a vital room in our facility that provides students with one hot free meal a day in connection to Dare to Care. The Kitchen will be renamed "Humana Healthy Horizons Kitchen" in recognition of their support to all our students at Lighthouse Academy at Newburg.

Humana Healthy Horizons, a segment of Humana Inc., is a managed care organization (MCO) that offers Medicaid to residents across Kentucky, in addition to four other states. With close to 82 million Americans on Medicaid in the United States (1), Medicaid is an essential and important service. Humana Healthy Horizons offers Medicaid eligibility based on income. In addition to offering all required Medicaid services set by the state and government, Humana Healthy Horizons has additional valued added benefits and rewards that sets them apart. Some of the unique programs they offer are the following:

- <u>HumanaBeginnings</u>, formally known as Moms First, is a program designed to assist new moms with education and appointments before and after childbirth. This program has implemented a rewards system where moms can receive up to \$110 in gift cards!
- <u>Doula Services</u> is another exciting, special program at Humana Healthy Horizons. Moms get a total of nine visits with a doula, four before the birth, four after, and one scheduled for delivery. Humana Healthy Horizons is billed directly.
- <u>Haircuts for Kids</u> School can be expensive at times. Children can benefit with two haircuts during the school year covered by Humana Healthy Horizons.

Open enrollment is quickly approaching for Humana Healthy Horizons. Medicaid enrollment takes place from October 17 – December 2, 2022.
